We have been made aware that two individuals who attended service this past Sunday, September 5th, have tested positive for COVID-19. They had been vaccinated and were wearing masks while sitting in the back of the sanctuary. This is known as a 'break through' case. That's why we have safety protocols in place. By them wearing masks and those who attend wear masks, the likelihood of transmission is low; however, if you show any symptoms, I encourage you to be tested. I along with some other staff members were tested to be on the safe side.

I cannot stress the need to be vaccinated. Everyone currently at the KU hospital on ventilators **were not vaccinated!** We're seeing a rise in positive COVID cases with our children and many school systems have been disrupted. This is due in part because children 12 and under are yet unable to be vaccinated.
