Our church has been built on a solid Apostolic foundation, focused on evangelism and rehabilitation. Some of the pillars of our church have been our Drug & Alcohol Ministry, Youth Ministry & Community Outreach, in addition to our radio & TV Ministry. We are a church of love, faith, and family.
